



Rainhill Cricket Club Accident Procedure

1. Immediate Response

- Remain calm, yet respond swiftly. Assess the situation to determine if there's a risk of it worsening or if there's potential for further injury.
- Listen attentively to the injured individual.

2. First Aid Intervention

- Promptly alert the qualified First Aider at the club. The First Aider should administer appropriate care for minor injuries.

3. Emergency Situations

- In cases where specialist treatment is necessary, immediately call emergency services at 999.

4. Managing the Group

- Ensure the rest of the group is safe and adequately supervised.

5. Handling Serious Injuries

- Do not move a person with major injuries. Await the arrival of emergency medical personnel.

6. Contacting Parents or Guardians

- As soon as possible, contact the injured person's parent, carer, or guardian to inform them of the situation.

7. Documentation

- Complete an Incident/Accident Report Form detailing the occurrence.

8. Reporting

- Submit the completed accident report form to the Club Welfare Officer for review and follow-up.
